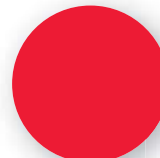


# Spot the risks!

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Good livestock farming practices make good sense.



## New stock

insist on a health declaration, isolate and monitor new stock for a week.



## Feed & water

only purchase clean, fresh products from quality assured suppliers, store to prevent contamination.



## Feral animals & pests

work with neighbours to control feral animals and pests.



## Vehicles & visitors

maintain a controlled entrance, record personnel visits, ensure visitor's boots and hands are clean.
